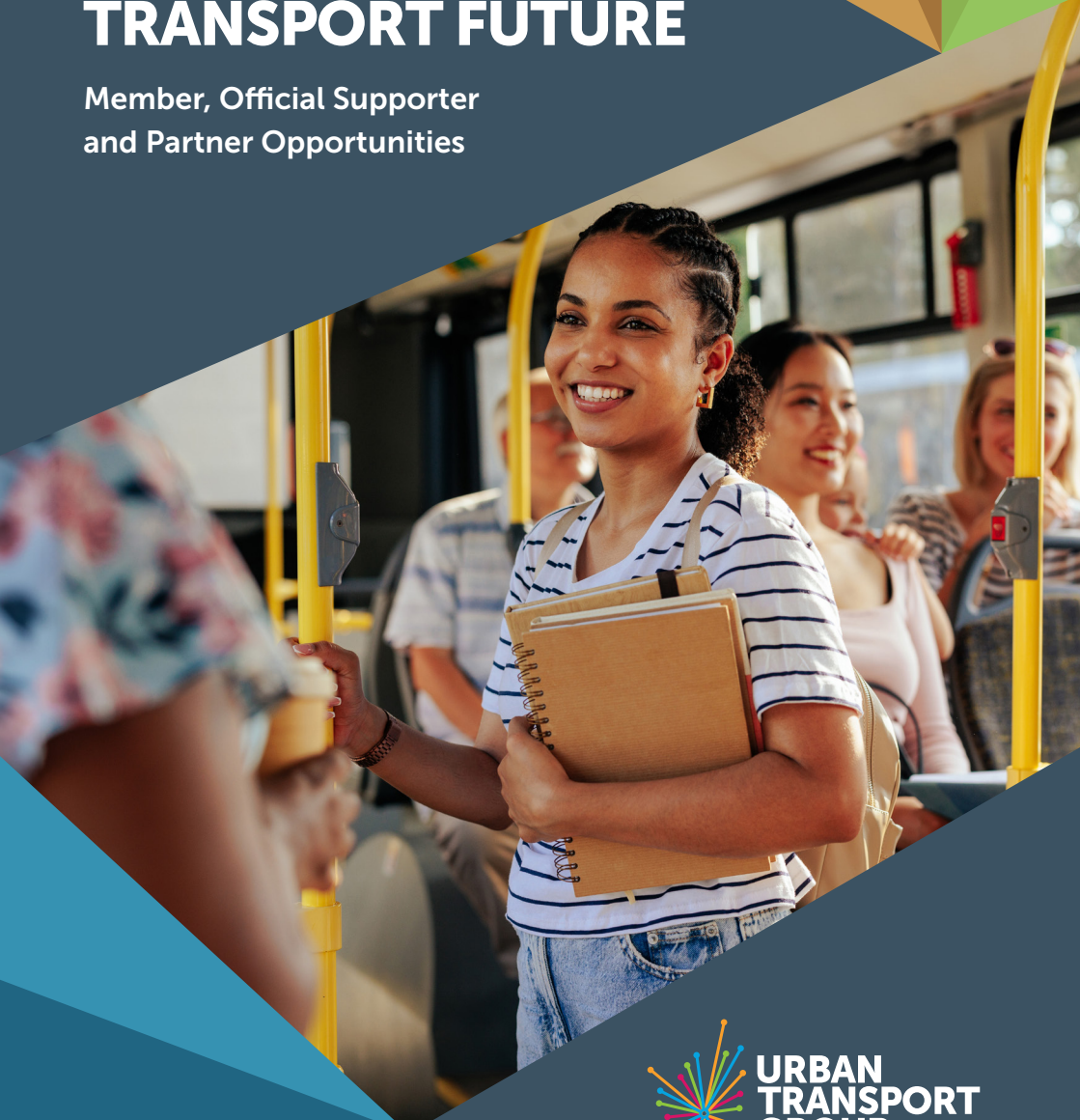

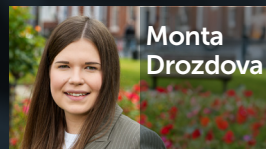

- Our 'A Smoother Ride' reports are moving the dial on how bus services are provided
- We've advocated on key transport issues such as the protection of bus funding and the campaign against the closure of rail ticket offices
- We've provided Secretariat support for the independent Rail and Urban Transport Review
- We're working closely with the UK Mayors Group (of Metro Mayors) on transport policy

THOUGHT LEADERSHIP AND STRONG RELATIONSHIPS

We believe strong partnerships are vital to achieve the best transport outcomes for our places. As well as working with our members, we collaborate with a range of organisations (across the public, private, charitable and academic sectors) to provide strong, united leadership on the most challenging issues facing transport.

- We have strong relationships with Government and especially the Department for Transport, with DfT Directors attending our Board of Directors' meetings
- We are the Secretariat for the refreshed City Regions Transport All Party Parliamentary Group, which brings together MPs and other key stakeholders for regular meetings
- Our Leadership Programme inspires fresh thinking and forges strong connections between senior leaders across our membership and beyond
- As a member of UITP (the International Association of Public Transport), we can both promote to, and learn from, our international partners, ensuring we look beyond our own borders for learning and best practice

ADVOCATES FOR PUBLIC TRANSPORT

We are passionate champions for public transport and active travel. Inspired by the work of our members, we use our collective voice to highlight the fundamental role which transport plays in delivering economic growth, social value and environmental goals.

- Our annual Party Conference activity, which sees us working with our members and partners such as Centre for Cities and Northern Powerhouse Partnership, ensures we engage across the political spectrum
- Our series of online Urban Transport Next conversations, which have included Metro Mayors as guests, demonstrates we are at the forefront of the debates on public transport
- We support and amplify the work of our members to Government, the wider transport industry and the media through a variety of channels, such as consultation responses and select committee hearings, industry events, and social and traditional media
- Our wide-ranging events programme, including our Parliamentary Reception, puts our work in front of audiences of influential decision makers and budget holders who can shape better transport outcomes
